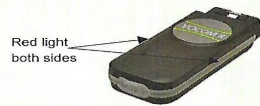

Error indicators



The error indicators light up when an error occurs. This means that something unexpected has happened, but it does not prevent you from using the device.

On the Status page in Configurator, you can check and clear the stored errors.

Power indicator



The power indicator blinks when the device starts up or runs an update. When the indicator light is stable, the device is ready to operate.

The color of the power indicator shows the battery condition of the connected vehicle/equipment.

24V Battery	12V Battery	Battery Condition	Color
More than 22.5V	More than 12.25V	Good	Green
22.2V – 24.3V	11.6V – 12.15V	Bad	Orange

First-time setup

1. Connect the wireless USB adapter to the USB port of your computer.
2. Connect the VOCOM II Mini to the OBD connector in the vehicle and turn the ignition on.
3. Open VOCOM II Configurator on your computer.



4. In Configurator, select your device.

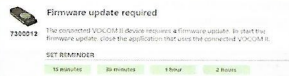
Note! Next time VOCOM II will connect automatically.

Firmware update

The first time you connect to a new device you may need to update the device firmware. The update starts automatically.

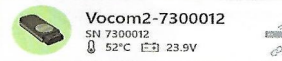


The firmware update cannot run while any diagnostic application is open, for example Tech Tool or VODIA. You will be reminded until the device is updated.



Using the device

Configurator shows the internal device temperature and the battery voltage of the connected vehicle/equipment.



Note! If the temperature reaches 65°C/149°F, it is recommended to cool it down to avoid auto turn off at 70°C/158°F.

Wi-Fi signal

Configurator shows the signal level of the Wi-Fi connection and notifies you if the Wi-Fi signal gets too weak.

Note! If the Wi-Fi signal level is weak, connection problems can occur.

You can also monitor your device status using the VOCOM II icon located in the Windows taskbar.
